We assess all our suppliers, our working procedures and methods of manufacture, to minimize and prevent pollution and wherever possible, any detrimental effect that goods or services supplied by Total Access (UK) Ltd have on the environment by:-

- Active compliance with all relevant environmental legislation.
- Establishment and review of environmental objectives based on this policy.
- Communication of our policy internally and externally.
- Striving to make continual improvements in our environmental performance.
- Meeting and where possible exceeding the environmental requirements of our clients.
- Sorting and manufacturing environmental objectives.

Means to achieve the above objectives include:

- Considering the environmental impact of all plant, equipment and assets throughout the whole lifecycle including disposal.
- Re-using packaging where possible
- Reducing waste production wherever feasible
- Recycling waste materials from production, warehouse, office and kitchen areas.
- Monitoring water, electricity, oil, gas and all other consumables.
- Minimising energy consumption throughout our premises.
- Minimising use of all other consumables- e.g. office supplies
- Preventing the production or release of contamination by air, land or water.
- Switching to low emission/ high MPG vehicles whenever feasible.
- Minimising vehicle numbers by pool car management.
- Reducing vehicle mileage through pre-journey planning.
- Promoting environmental awareness amongst our suppliers.
- Open discussion with staff and others in relation to environmental matters.
- Giving responsibility for implementing this policy to a senior employee, answerable to the directors.

Responsibility

Overall responsibility for the implementation and review of this policy rests with the Managing Director.

The General Manager is responsible for the overall coordination of quality, health, safety and environmental matters throughout the Company.

Directors, Managers and Project Managers are responsible for ensuring that this policy is fully implemented in their areas of control.

Employees are responsible for ensuring that they maintain the highest personal standards to protect the environment.

Policy Review

This policy is reviewed (and revised if necessary) at least annually or when there are relevant changes in law or if new environmental hazards are identified.
